- *Entries may be **dropped off** at the Community Center on Monday, 8 am to 8 pm, Tuesday 8 am to 8 pm or Wednesday, 8 am to noon.
- *Entries should be **picked up** on Sunday after the show's closing or on Monday between 8 am and 7 pm. Any work left will be disposed of after Friday, March 30.
- *Where possible, work will be displayed according to the following: children 5-12 years, teens 13-19 years, and adults 20 & older.
