We feel so fortunate to get to play a small part in providing this opportunity for girls to make some really special memories! Some great memories are made, and it hopefully solidifies the relationships that will be so important for the girls in the coming years."

Renfroe went on to explain that Happy Dave Blaylock provides the sound equipment, and he acts as the event's host. "We could not have this event without Dave Blaylock! Dave has such a heart for the girls, having raised two daughters himself, and seeing them with their dads is such a blessing!"

The department had a professional photographer, Katee Bratcher Photography, shooting pictures of the event. Renfroe explained, "This is a great opportunity to get pictures of the girls and dads all dressed up and having fun together. Lots of moms want to have pictures to remember the event but don't want to intrude on the dads' time, so we provide a way for them to remember the big night." 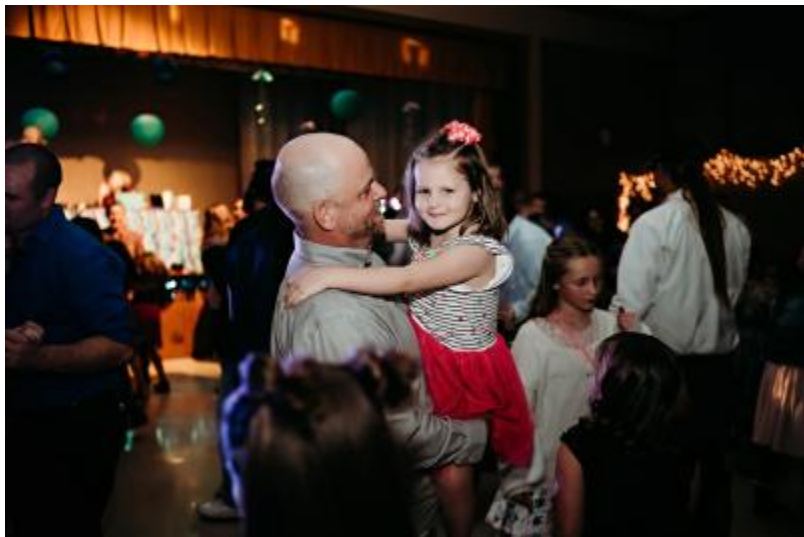
